Provides payment of medical services through the Ohio Department of Health for children with special health care needs. Also provides public health nursing services to those families and children by:

- Visiting the family and/or child in the home, school or health department or other place agreed on by the family
- Explaining the BCMH program, letter of approval and assisting with BCMH paperwork
- Helping the family understand their child's plan of treatment
- Helping the family learn about their child's growth and development
- Helping the family locate BCMH providers for medical services
- Providing referrals to additional community resources & working with other agencies to make sure the child's needs are being met

Lead Poisoning Prevention

Provides case management on children with blood lead levels greater than 5 ug/dL. Educational materials are available through the Ohio Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program

Child & Adolescent Vaccines

Routine vaccines for birth through 18 years of age are available through the Ohio Dept. of Health and the Federally-Funded Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program for qualifying uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid clients
\$10 Fee per Child (1st shot)
\$5 each additional shot

No child is turned away for inability to pay for state-supplied vaccines.

Private vaccines are available for privately-insured children

Adult Vaccines

(age 19 years & over)

- Tetanus-diphtheria (Td)
- Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap)
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal (up to age 55)
- Meningococcal B
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- Pneumococcal - age 65 & over – (Pneumovax and Prevnar13)
- Zoster (Shingles) - age 50 & older

Tdap vaccine is available for \$10 for uninsured parents of babies.
Hepatitis A & B vaccines are available for \$10 for high risk uninsured adults.
