2016-2017 Annual Report

Summary:

- All of our Resident Educators (REs) in year 3 successfully passed the ODE required Resident Educator Summative Assessment (RESA) the first time taking it: a 100% passage rate! A total of 5 teachers district-wide and 2 from MYA.
- The rest of our REs completed L-P's Resident Educator (RE) Program requirements for this year and are eligible to advance to the next level in L-P's RE Program.
- 6 REs are finished with L-P's RE Program and are eligible to apply for their 5-year professional teaching licenses; 4 teachers district-wide and 2 teachers from MYA.
- Our district total for L-P's RE Program in 2016-2017 was 27 Resident Educators.
- Met w/ L-P Superintendent, John Miller, several times throughout the year to receive direction and provide program information & updates.

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- Provided PD opportunities to Resident Educators in year 3 for RESA preparation.
 - Conducted meetings for all REs and their Mentors/Facilitators/Colleagues to review L-P's Resident Educator Program requirements and supports.
 - Registered each RE with their Mentor/Facilitator/Colleague in the ODE CORE data system for beginning-of-the-year and end-of-the-year reporting.
 - Verified Mentor training for years 1 & 2 and coordinated all assignments of REs with a Mentor/Facilitator/Colleague.
 - Refined timelines (yearly) and monthly checklists for REs in program years 1 & 2: These outline L-P RE program tasks, tools and end-of-the year participation verification documents.
 - Recorded monthly/yearly documentation of REs' participation in years 1 & 2.
 - Regularly communicated with all REs and their Mentors/Facilitators/Colleagues.
 - Worked with REs in year 4 and Colleagues to pursue meaningful leadership explorations: Recorded program completion documentation for all REs in year 4.
 - Participated in ODE RE Program Coordinator's Network Meetings & other PD.
